



Safer Space Agreement

Welcome to Trans Day of Remembrance community on-line spaces for care.

We are here to support in facilitating safer spaces of care during this challenging time. We encourage everyone to take part in a safe and supportive manner, respecting our Safer Space agreement.

The facilitators and trainers will do their best to ensure everyone has a safe and engaging session. Please respect the facilitators and let them lead the session. Violent terminology, language and views (e.g. racism, homophobia, sexism, ableism) will not be tolerated.

Although the content has been carefully considered, these are potentially emotionally draining topics and some of it could be triggering. Feel free to step out of the session, log off / back in, or request to enter a break-out room for mental health support during the session.

Fairness: we all have different levels of understanding and different styles of learning. Be impartial and do not be quick to judge.

Respect: this is a confidential space. Do not repeat information that has been shared without consent. People express themselves in different ways, please listen, and be mindful and inclusive about difference. Remember if you want to challenge something, then challenge the behaviour or belief and not the person.

Equality: as far as possible the spaces will be inclusive so people can access it at different levels based on their own need.

Dignity: please do not shame or belittle someone, or make assumptions about their experiences. It is disruptive, hurtful and damaging.

Autonomy: you have the right to pass on activities you do not want to participate in. Do not coerce others to participate.

We are all on our unique journey, please respect one another's identity, pronouns and be aware that many of us have had very different experiences to each other.
